



## 7th Grade Immunization Notice

In accordance with the Utah Department of Health requirements, this notice is to inform you of the immunizations requirement for students entering 7th grade. All students must submit proof of receiving all required immunizations required for school entry. This includes all previously submitted immunizations and 2 additional vaccines.

Starting in 7th grade, all students must also provide proof of receiving the following additional vaccines:


1 dose of Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis (Tdap) **booster**

1 dose of Meningococcal (*Only Meningococcal vaccine given after 10 years of age is acceptable for 7th grade school entry*)

Proof of immunity to disease(s) can be accepted in place of vaccination **ONLY** if a document from a health care provider stating the student previously contracted the disease is presented to the school.

If you choose not to have your child immunized, you must obtain a Utah Department of Health Exemption Certificate obtained by completing the Online Immunization Education Module (<https://immunize.utah.gov/immunization-education-module/>) and present the certificate to the Front Office to be placed in your child's file at school.

If your child is unable to complete all the doses of the required immunizations prior to the start of the school year, your child will be excluded from attending school until you are able to submit record of the completed immunizations.



## Immunization Requirements 7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Entry (2026-2027)

To attend 7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade, a student must provide written proof of receiving the following immunizations:

- ◆ **1 dose of Tdap** (*Only Tdap vaccine given at age 10 years or older is acceptable for school entry*)
- ◆ **2 doses of Varicella (chickenpox)**
- ◆ **1 dose of Meningococcal Conjugate** (*Only Meningococcal Conjugate vaccine given at age 10 years or older is acceptable for school entry*)
- ◆ **3 doses of Hepatitis B**
- ◆ **2 doses of Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)**
- ◆ **4 doses of Polio**
- ◆ **2 doses of Hepatitis A**
- ◆ **Proof of receiving 5 doses of DTaP**, or, if never or not fully vaccinated, proof of receiving the appropriate number of Td or Tdap doses based on the student's age.

### Recommended

(Not required for school entry in Utah)


- ◆ HPV
- ◆ Influenza
- ◆ COVID-19

For students claiming a previous infection with Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR), Varicella (Chickenpox), or Hepatitis A, immunity documents must be provided to the school. These documents should include the results of serological/titer testing and a written statement signed by a healthcare provider confirming that, based on positive laboratory test results, the student does not need to receive the MMR, varicella, or hepatitis A vaccines.

For medical, religious, or personal exemptions, the legally responsible individual of the student must complete an online immunization education module at [immunize.utah.gov](https://immunize.utah.gov) or attend an in-person consultation at a local health department. A copy of the exemption form must be submitted to the school.

For medical exemptions, a completed vaccination exemption form, along with a written notice signed by a licensed healthcare provider, must be submitted to the school.

## Requisitos de inmunización para ingresar desde el 7º a 12º grado (2026-2027)

Para asistir del 7º al 12º grado, el estudiante debe presentar un comprobante escrito de haber recibido las siguientes vacunas:

- ◆ **1 dosis de Tdap** (*La nica vacuna Tdap que se administra a los 10 años o más es aceptable para el ingreso a la escuela*)
- ◆ **2 dosis de varicela**
- ◆ **1 dosis de conjugado meningocócico** (*solo la vacuna antimeningocócica conjugada administrada a los 10 años o más es aceptable para ingresar a la escuela*)
- ◆ **3 dosis de hepatitis B**
- ◆ **2 dosis de sarampión, paperas, rubéola (MMR, por sus siglas en inglés)**
- ◆ **4 dosis de polio**
- ◆ **2 dosis de hepatitis A**
- ◆ **Comprobante de haber recibido 5 dosis de DTaP**, o si nunca fue vacunado o no está completamente vacunado, comprobante de haber recibido el número apropiado de dosis de Td o Tdap según la edad del niño.

### Recomendado

(no obligatorio para ingresar a la escuela en Utah):

- ◆ Virus de Papiloma Humano (VPH)
- ◆ Influenza
- ◆ COVID-19

Para los estudiantes que afirmen haber tenido una infección previa con sarampión, paperas, rubéola (MMR), varicela o hepatitis A, se deben presentar documentos de inmunidad a la escuela. Estos documentos deben incluir los resultados de las pruebas serológicas o de titulación y una declaración escrita firmada por un proveedor de atención médica que confirme que, con base en los resultados positivos de las pruebas de laboratorio, el estudiante no necesita recibir las vacunas contra MMR, varicela o hepatitis A.

Para exenciones médicas, religiosas o personales, la persona legalmente responsable del estudiante debe completar un módulo de educación sobre vacunas en línea en [immunize.utah.gov](https://immunize.utah.gov) o asistir a una consulta en persona en un departamento de salud local. Se debe presentar una copia del formulario de exención a la escuela.

Para las exenciones médicas, se debe presentar a la escuela un formulario de exención de vacunación completado, junto con un aviso por escrito firmado por un proveedor de atención médica autorizado.
