7:20 pm	 Director's Update-Mark Ursic Update on the parking lot project. The front parking will be completed for opening. Back areas will be completed during Fall Break. The school received a 5-year renewal on our accreditation from Cognia Completed a state audit of school fees. We were issued a corrective action letter for requested changes to some of our existing policies and a directive to begin using a contra-revenue account for school fee waivers. The state provided the language they would like to see, and the policies will be amended accordingly. We have eliminated school fees for in-school activities. Reviewed proposed fee schedule for the 2023-24 school year Reviewed enrollment numbers. Enrollment looks very strong, and if current trends continue, we should have the highest Oct 1 count since we opened. Last year, Oct 1-768. Currently, Aspire shows 808 students registered. The charter cap is 780. MU answered board questions about the methodology for tracking students who re-enroll but drop out before school starts. The board requests an enhanced effort to track transfer requests.
