## SOCIAL SKILLS CLASSES

#### Dear Renaissance Parents/Guardians,

This year we will be offering social skills development and personal boundaries education classes to all elementary students in grades Kindergarten - 4th. The lessons taught in this program are designed to promote student safety and boundaries, and teach some specific social skills elementary students may struggle with on a daily basis. We believe all of our students in K-4 would benefit from the skills taught and support provided in a social skills and boundaries education class.

Social skills training will be delivered in a group setting in the regular education classroom and will be taught by Nettie Naumann, RA School Counselor. Specific skills that we will be working on throughout the year include conversation skills (personal space, turn-taking, entering a conversation, staying on topic, etc.), perspective taking (identifying what others are thinking/feeling, etc.), play skills (how to enter a game appropriately, following rules, dealing with losing, etc.), emotion management (dealing with anger), classroom skills (raising hands, etc.), and many, many more. We will also discuss appropriate and interpersonal boundaries, and inappropriate touching.

The Nemelka Family of Mapleton is pleased to sponsor the 30<sup>th</sup> Annual Christmas Lamb Art Show at the Springville Museum of Art. This exhibition will be on view at the Museum in the Ingrid F. Nemelka Gallery from December 5, 2015 through January 3, 2016. The Museum will select a number of works to be included in the exhibition. Of those selected for display, a small number will be chosen for cash prizes! Please note: In previous years all works in the exhibition received cash prizes. To allow more art in the show, those selected for awards will receive cash prizes. **Most of the exhibited works will not receive a cash prize.** 

This competition is open to students living within Utah Valley. We ask for your support in announcing and publicizing this upcoming exhibition. Many schools offer this to students along with similar events such as the PTA Reflections Art Contest and allow students to enter one or both at their parents' discretion. Works for this show should be of a spiritual theme and reflect the spirit of giving associated with the holiday season (Santa Claus images are discouraged). The works will be juried by the SMA Education staff. The works are to be original and individually conceived by the students, rather than class projects. No works will be considered if they contain glitter, candy, glued-on beans, macaroni or similar material that tend to fall off when handled or invite bugs into the Museum.

Teachers may bring entries to the Museum from Tuesday through Friday, November 10-13, 2015, 10 am to 5 pm. As a result of the growing popularity of this show, we ask each school to limit their entries to no more than 100. Each student is limited to one entry. Please be sure to include the artist's first and last name, home phone number, grade, school, and teacher's name on the back of the artwork.

A list of accepted works will be posted on smofa.org on November 20, 2015. We will phone each award winner's home to invite them to the award ceremony. Students in the exhibition who do not receive awards will not receive a personal phone call; however, all exhibiting artists along with their families and teachers, are invited to join us for the reception on Saturday, December 5, 2015 at 11:00am. You are also invited to visit the Museum during regular hours throughout December to see the selected works on display. Artwork should be picked up by January 29, 2016. Art will not be retained after January 2016.
